





A little bit of bistory...

Today's Zagreb has grown from two medieval settlements that developed for centuries on the neighbouring hills — Gradec and Kaptol. With traces of human settlements dating back to prehistoric times, the first written mention of Zagreb dates back to 1094 and the founding of the Diocese of Kaptol. The Golden Bull, a document issued in 1242 by the Croatian-Hungarian King Bela IV, granted Gradec considerable privileges and status as a free royal town. The unification of the existing settlements in 1850 created the conditions for the development of a modern Central European city.

From the first pharmacy to the university

Zagreb can boast its pharmacy tradition going back many centuries, as evidenced by the opening of the first Zagreb pharmacy in Kamenita ulica 9, in the middle of the 14th century. On this rich tradition, based on the decision of Emperor Franz Joseph I, in 1882 the Pharmacy Teaching Course was established at the University of Zagreb, opening the way for the study of pharmacy.

The history of the School of Dental Medicine begins in 1892 with the foundation of the Odontology Chair. The Faculty of Medicine joined it in 1918 in transferring scientific and medical knowledge, although the first requirements for the establishment of a medical studies date back to 1790.

Laser dioptre removal is among the most popular interventions, and Zagreb clinics have state-of-the-art equipment, including the advanced femto-LASIK method (All-Laser LASIK). In case you are not a candidate for the laser, a solution exists nonetheless, in the form of dioptre correction by implanting special intraocular lens (ICL).



With its surroundings, Zagreb has become a leading health tourism centre, recognized for the establishment of specialized clinics and hospitals that have become a place for training experts and for the introduction of innovative treatment methods and new technologies.

Innovative procedures

The St. Catherine Specialty Hospital is among the few European institutions that first started using mesenchymal stem cells (MSC) in clinical practice, and the first in Southeast Europe to introduce a new meniscus transplantation procedure. The potential of St. Catherine hospital has also been recognized by the European Commission, allocating it and the Genos laboratory HRK 17 million of non-refundable funds for the development of new diagnostic and therapeutic procedures for the treatment of lumbago.

The Zagreb dental offices follow and set trends, implementing laser, implant and digital technology in their work, while the leaders among them treat edentulousness with innovative pterygoid and All-on-4 and Zygoma All-on-4 dental implants.



The professional team of *Radiochirurgia Zagreb*, a private clinic for diagnosis and treatment of cancer, consists of specialists trained in leading national and international centres. They have the state-of-the-art technology for diagnosing and treating tumours including, among others, the Varian EDGE radiotherapy and radiosurgical device, which introduces evolution into advanced radiosurgery.

In the role of a leader

Zagreb is a home to superior aesthetic clinics with state-ofthe-art technology, such as the VECTRA 3D device, which allows for simulation of postoperative appearance, or innovative laser technology used daily by the Bagatin Clinic experts. You will also find top-notch ophthalmic clinics and experts in Zagreb, including Prof. Nikica Gabrić, MD, PhD and Prof. Iva Dekaris, MD, PhD from the University Eye Hospital Svjetlost, Croatian pioneers of corneal transplantation, with more than a thousand transplants.

The founder of the IVF Polyclinic, the first private polyclinic for gynaecology, obstetrics and reproductive medicine, Prof. Velimir Šimunić, MD, PhD, is one of the pioneers of medically assisted fertilization, and the leader of a team of experts who in 1982, as the seventh in the world, enabled the conception and birth of the first Croatian IVF baby. Thanks to this experience, top technology and quality of service, nowadays the polyclinic competes on equal footing with leading European centres.

Prof. Gordan Lauc, PhD, is the founder of Genos, first private DNA laboratory in the region, one of the leading scientific institutions in Croatia in the field of DNA analysis and a world leader in glycan analysis. With the implementation of genetic tests, their work contributes to the development of personalized medicine for the purpose of an individualized approach to diagnosis and treatment based on the genome analysis of patients.

Long standing tradition of quality

The first catheterization and later heart transplantation in Croatia was performed at the *Heart and Blood Vessel Disease Clinic* at the University Hospital Zagreb, where more than 700 local and foreign cardiologists have been trained.

Among them are the founders of the Heart and Blood Vessel Disease Clinic at the University Hospital Dubrava and the Magdalena — Clinic for Cardiovascular Medicine in Krapinske Toplice, and today these three centres compete with the world's best cardiovascular disease centres.





University Hospital Merkur is the world's leading hospital according to the number of transplanted livers per million inhabitants, with a 96% success rate, also known for transplantation of non-conforming blood groups.

The Paediatric Surgery Clinic, within the Zagreb *Children's Hospital*, brings together almost half of Croatian paediatric surgeons, and is also the organizer of the First World Congress of Paediatric Surgery.





A green embrace from the north

Apart from gently looking over Zagreb on the northern side, Medvednica, a favourite place among all the Zagreb locals, is a protected nature park which encompasses eight forest reserves. It is home to a lot of plant and animal species, geologically diverse, as evidenced by the cave of Veternica, one of the most important Croatian paleontological sites.

Inhale, exhale!

True, its trails are a popular weekend destination, and not just for recreation and socializing, but also for the much-needed break from the urban jungle. Medvednica provides Zagreb locals with new opportunities for relaxing in fresh air, surrounded by greenery and the smells of the forest — so breathe in deeply the fragrant air and breathe out the stress.

A wealth of drinking water Within the Medvednica Nature Park there are 450 km of surface watercourses, and there are many well-maintained springs of drinking water. Some of them, not so long ago, served as water supply to some of the local villages, but to this day the sight of them delights thirsty hikers. In addition to being a sanctuary for a variety of river fauna and an essential part of the ecosystem, one cannot deny their contribution to the beauty of the landscape – because the sound of trickling water in the forest is a



signal for peace and relaxation.

Centennial Maksimir forest

It is well known that Zagreb has plenty of parks (if you haven't yet, you should definitely stroll along the Green Horseshoe, the magnificent complex of squares and parks in the city centre), while the thick centennial forest of the Maksimir Park is the first public park in Southeast Europe.

It was opened to the public back in 1794, and encompasses five lakes, educational and recreational trails, as well as the Zoo, the Echo Pavilion and the Vidikovac (Bellevue) building.

Jarun or Bundek?

Bundek was the first and most popular swimming spot in Zagreb, created in 1955 through the excavation and removal of gravel. But after it was closed, Jarun, designed in 1987 for the needs of the University Games, became the number one site. With the redevelopment and reopening of Bundek in 2006, the dilemma we presented in the title became current and now every Zagreb local has their own favourite swimming spot.

But whatever you choose, you will not go wrong — and while Bundek is considered a destination intended for family gathering and relaxation, Jarun is more focused on sports, entertainment and recreation.



5 | Let's have coffee!

The Zagreb locals always find the time for coffee – even business deals are concluded over coffee — and the best one is at the Saturday "Špica", which takes place in cafes around the Petar Preradović Square, also known as the Flower Square.



6 | View from the top Climb up to the 16th floor of the skyscraper on Zagreb's main square and enjoy a 360-degree view of the city. In addition to the viewpoint, there is also a bar where you can sip a drink while enjoying

the view.

7 | Take a green break

Zagreb boasts a large number of green areas, and the so-called Lenuci's Horseshoe (known as the Green Horseshoe), which stretches through the centre of the city, unites a series of squares and parks from the 19th century.

8 | Discover Zagreb's tunnels Kilometres of tunnels that allegedly pass under Zagreb are a mystery for many Zagreb locals, but one is known and open to the public the Grič tunnel, which connects Mesnička and Radićeva Street. 9 | Fresh from the dining table Zagreb would not be what it is today without the "stomach of the city" — the Dolac market. Take a peek under the red parasols and find something for yourself in the rich offer of fresh foods.

10 | Gingerbread heart as a souvenir

To have an unforgettable memory of your visit to Zagreb, choose a unique souvenir — gingerbread heart, a traditional vividly decorated souvenir made of honey dough.









Zagreb the 4 seasons throughout

In every season, Zagreb shows a new face, due to events where city streets and squares pulsate with new energy and vibrancy. So, if you are wondering when the best time to visit Zagreb is, the answer is — right now!

Awakening of spring

A sure sign of the spring awakening in Zagreb is the Festival of Lights, when famous Zagreb sites become playful locations of light effects.

From the end of April (until the beginning of October) you have the opportunity to jump into the Zagreb Time Machine and experience a Zagreb from times long past.

The playful spring atmosphere is brought to the city by two events that are already traditional — during the international street festival Cest is d'Best the entire city becomes a stage, and thanks to the international Floraart flower exhibition, Zagreb's Bundek literally blossoms. The event Summer on Stross starts at the end of May as the best announcement of a summer full of events.

Summer in the city

Summer on the city asphalt does not have to be boring — while the Design District Zagreb is taking place, the entire block around Martićeva Street is transformed into a design, art and entertainment area.

June is already traditionally marked by the INmusic festival, the largest open-air festival that has been listed several times among the most important international festivals.

The event that has been taking place for decades, The International Folklore Festival, as well as the musical event Evenings on Grič, also stand out.

Warm summer evenings are an invitation for outdoor delights — this is why the Zagreb Classic is an ideal excuse for a picnic on the grass of the King Tomislav Square accompanied by the sound of classical music, while the summer stage of the Tuškanac cinema is the perfect setting for the films of the Fantastic Zagreb Film Festival.



The secrets of Grič will be revealed to you by an interactive nocturnal tour of the same name. Also, make sure to take the opportunity to peek behind the façades of Baroque palaces during the Courtyards event.

Autumn rhapsody

The beginning of October in Zagreb is marked by the Open Square Day, when the cultural and educational institutions of the Republic of Croatia Square open their doors. The Zagreb Film Festival and its Golden Pram Award are an event that should not be missed, just like the Zagreb Marathon, with one of the fastest marathon trails.

You simply have to try "štrukle" in Zagreb, a savoury or sweet dish made with a special kind of dough and filled with cow cheese.

Cheese and sour cream

Cheese with sour cream is one of the traditional dishes of Zagreb and its surroundings — it can be eaten without any sides or be served as a side dish, enriched with fresh spices.

Turkey with *mlinci*A specialty reserved for special occasions, turkey is always

accompanied by *mlinci*, a thin dried flatbread made of flour, salt and water, with the addition of a pan sauce.

Knedle

Sweet potato dumplings, filled with plum or apricot, are often found on the tables of the Zagreb locals.

Apples strudel



The Zagreb locals have been going to the same pharmacy, K crnom orlu (its name translates to "At the Black Eagle's"), for the past 700 years. Since at the time of its foundation in the middle of the 14th century there were no house numbers, it was recognized by the black eagle above the door.


Nicolo Alighieri, grandson of the renowned writer Dante Alighieri, also worked in the Upper Town pharmacy.

In 1896, the Pharmacognosy Institute was established in Zagreb, as the first independent institute of its kind in the world. The highest annual award of the Croatian Pharmaceutical Society has been named after its founder, pharmacist Julije Domac.

All the way until the end of the 19th century, when its course was regulated, the Medveščak stream ran through the centre of Zagreb, with the city baths and entertainment areas along its banks.

In Varaždinske Toplice, only half an hour from Zagreb, excavations have revealed a Roman complex of public thermal baths more than two thousand years old.



*

When Krapinske Toplice was visited by Archbishop Esterhazy, the baths were of too low a standard for such an esteemed guest. Therefore, a gazebo made of branches was quickly erected so that the bishop could peacefully change and prepare for bathing — that was the first changing room of the baths.




